

SCALE SYSTEM OF GRADING AT POLYTECH LILLE

Each training unit (or module) is composed of different courses. Each course is assigned its own grade-weighting factor (coefficient)

As for the table of grades, our system ranges from 0 (the lowest) to 20 (the highest) and the passing mark for a single subject is 10/20. The correspondence with the ECTS grades is the following for each course.

The best 10% are awarded an A grade, the next 25% a B grade, the following 30% a C, the following 25% a D and the final 10% an E. Those who have not achieved a performance sufficient to allow a passing grade receive a “F” (Fail).

The assessments are either homework, projects or practical work evaluations, either written examinations. They can take place at the end of each module. But a number of them may occur at the end of the semester.

The workload for an academic year is 60 ECTS credits.

This system can be represented in a table, as follows:

ECTS grading scale:

ECTS Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	EXCELLENT – outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	25	VERY GOOD – above the average standard but with some errors
C	30	GOOD – generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	25	SATISFACTORY – fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	SUFFICIENT – performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	-	FAIL – some more work required before the credit can be awarded
F	-	FAIL – considerable further work is required
P	-	PASS – module validated but not enough students in the class to use the ECTS grading scale
