## Erasmus + students

Polytech Lille has established Erasmus agreements with a number of universities in Europe, in the different fields of engineering.

Every year, Polytech Lille is pleased to host exchange students from partner institutions for one semester or on full year.

If you are registered as a student in one of our Erasmus + partner universities, you may apply to spend one semester or one academic year at Polytech Lille.

Our school offers 7 degree courses in engineering from the third to the fifth year of higher education leading to the "Diplôme d'Ingénieur" (=Master of Engineering).

Exchange students must have sufficient skills in the French language to follow classes (a level B1 on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages is recommended). We do not require an official certification but request from our partner institutions to check the language competences of the candidates before nominating them.

There is also the possibility to carry out projects or thesis works supervised by researchers of Polytech Lille within Erasmus programme.

The research project may be done in the premises of Polytech Lille or in one of the research laboratories of Lille 1 University, where the academic staff of Polytech Lille are doing their research activities.

## **Application procedure**

Exchange students who wish to study at Polytech Lille should first contact the International Office at their home institution. Once they have been nominated by them, they should fill in our Erasmus application form and provisional learning agreement.
